You are our partners in Education. So, it is important for you to be aware of the rules and regulations of the school. We request you to ensure that your ward adheres to these in order to enjoy his educational journey with us.

- School Timings for students : 7:40 am 1:40 pm
- Punctuality as a value should be inculcated in the students, so coming late to school should be discouraged. School gates will be closed at **7:40 am**. After that the child will be marked late. The child would be sent back after three late arrivals in a month.
- The "Student's diary" is an important document which must be brought to school daily. Parents are requested to go through it thoroughly and guide their ward to follow the instructions given in it.
- Students must abide by the <u>code of conduct</u> as mentioned in the school diary.
- Please check the School website regularly for latest updates.
- Please make it a point to meet the teachers during the PTMs as per the time schedule.
- Students accompanying their parents on PTM days should come in proper school uniform.
- Second and Fourth Saturday are off for the students. First and Third Saturday are working for the students and the regular school timings will be followed.
- Parents can meet the concerned teachers on First and Third Saturdays between 8:00 a.m. 9:00 a.m. after taking prior appointment.
- The students should come to school in **proper uniform** as prescribed in the school diary.
- It is mandatory for students to appear in all the examinations/activities and submit all projects on time.
- Please ensure that your ward has at least 75% attendance in school according to CBSE norms.
- Please do not ask for half day or short leave for students.
- Students will be allowed to park only their bicycles within the school campus. They will not be allowed to bring any other vehicle to the school.
- Kindly do not come to school to hand over the lunch boxes to the students during the school hours. <u>Restrict</u> <u>daily pocket money</u> as excessive spending should be discouraged.
- Kindly check that your ward should not bring SMART DEVICES like mobile phones, tablets, watches & bands to school. If found, it will be confiscated and will be returned to parents at the end of the session. A fine of Rs. 5000/ will be charged for the same.
- Mobile alerts are sent to parents for important information. Kindly ensure that your correct mobile number is registered with the school. <u>Change in residential address</u> or telephone number should be intimated immediately to school for necessary action with requisite proof.
- Students are issued I-Card which is to be worn by the students every day. Parents will also be issued I-Card which they must always carry while visiting school.
